Children's Pastor and other ministry jobs as assigned. In 2011 Jim founded the 10-33 Foundation to help all first responders and their families lead healthy and balanced professional and private lives. In 2015 the 10-33 Foundation was expanded to include services to global first responders, our military personnel and their families. In 2020, at the height of a global pandemic, Jim led a team of 13 crisis intervention specialist and counselors to New York city to provide frontline crisis mental health support to over 5,000 travel nurses serving in New York.
